

# MAX PLANCK INSTITUTE LUXEMBOURG

## CPLJ Commitment

- (1) I commit myself to participating in the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg's Project "Comparative Procedural Law and Justice" (hereafter, CPLJ), which is financially supported by the Luxembourg National Research Fund (FNR – O19/13946847). I have due knowledge of the CPLJ Project Description and the CPLJ Working Guidelines.
- (2) I will receive full credit and acknowledgement as participant of the CPLJ Project at all times. This will at least entail: **(i)** Recognition as CPLJ participant in all the project-related activities; **(ii)** Opportunity to discuss and comment on the work-in-progress activities of the CPLJ Project; **(iii)** Opportunity to write chapters or sub-chapters for the Compendium on Comparative Procedural Law, in the terms set forth in the Project Description and in the Working Guidelines; **(iv)** Access to the CPLJ Online Collaborative Platform and its visible contents; **(v)** Opportunity to participate in all CPLJ conferences; **(vi)** Travel and accommodation expenses for attending CPLJ conferences paid against the Project budget; **(vii)** Support and assistance by the Editorial Board, the Scientific Advisory Board and the MPI team in all CPLJ activities; **(viii)** Opportunity to come anytime to the Max Institute Luxembourg as a preferential guest, as well as to give presentations within the lectures series of the Institute.
- (3) My authorship and intellectual property rights will be duly respected, in accordance with common practice within the academic community and with the following statements: **(i)** I guarantee the originality of my chapters and/or sub-chapters; **(ii)** I grant to the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg (including its authorized agents working as editors of the Compendium) first publication rights to my chapters or sub-chapters, and agree that they will not be published, in whole or in part, in any other source prior to their publication in the Compendium without the express written permission of Max Planck Institute Luxembourg; **(iii)** I grant to the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg a non-exclusive license to publish, reproduce, display, and distribute my chapter or sub-chapters in any language and in any form including, but not limited to, print, electronic, and digital media, microfiche, microfilm, and any form necessary for inclusion in computerized retrieval systems, or any other format; **(iv)** I additionally grant to the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg the right to transfer, assign, or sublicense the rights granted herein without limitation; **(v)** I accept that the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg may exercise any rights granted herein directly or by means of



third parties, including by authorization of third party publishers, aggregators, and printers to publish my chapters or subchapters or to include the chapters or subchapters in a database or other services such as Westlaw, LEXIS, HeinOnline, JSTOR, and ProQuest.
