Marco Ventoruzzo is Professor of Law at Bocconi University in Milan (Italy), and at Penn State Dickinson School of Law (U.S.A.), where he teaches corporations and securities regulation. He is an External Scientific Member of the Max Planck Institute Luxembourg.

He is the Vice Director of the Paolo Baffi Center at Bocconi University, and a research affiliate of the ECGI. Professor Ventoruzzo holds a B.A. in Business and Economics from Bocconi University, a J.D. from Università di Milano, an LL.M. from Yale Law School and a Ph.D. from Università di Brescia.

Marco Ventoruzzo has taught and lectured at many law schools in Europe, the U.S. and Asia; and has written extensively in the field of business law. He is a member of the managing boards of the *Rivista delle società* and of the *European Company and Financial Law Review*.
