Prof. Alvarez, currently the Herbert and Rose Rubin Professor of International Law at New York University, was previously the Hamilton Fish Professor of International Law and Diplomacy and the executive director of the Center on Global Legal Problems at Columbia University. He served as President of the American Society of International Law (2006-2008) and is now the co-editor in chief of the *American Journal of International Law*.

He has published extensively on international investment and international organizations. His books include *The Public International Law Regime Governing International Investment* (2011), *The Impact of International Organizations on International Law* (2016), and *The American Contribution to International Investment Law* (forthcoming).

Prof. Alvarez is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and the Institut de Droit International. His *pro bono* activities include service on the US Department of State's Advisory Committee on Public International Law, the board of the Center for Reproductive Rights, and as special adviser on public international law to the International Criminal Court's first prosecutor.
