Lauge Poulsen is Associate Professor at the Department of Political Science, University College London. His research focuses on the theory and practise of economic diplomacy with a particular emphasis on foreign investment, dispute settlement, and international economic law.

Poulsen's first book *„Bounded Rationality and Economic Diplomacy: The Politics of Investment Treaties in Developing Countries“* won the International Studies Association's inaugural award for best book in International Political Economy. His second book *„The Political Economy of the Investment Treaty Regime“* was published in July 2017 (co-authored).

Lauge Poulsen is Academic Advisor on Trade Policy to the UK Foreign & Commonwealth Office.
