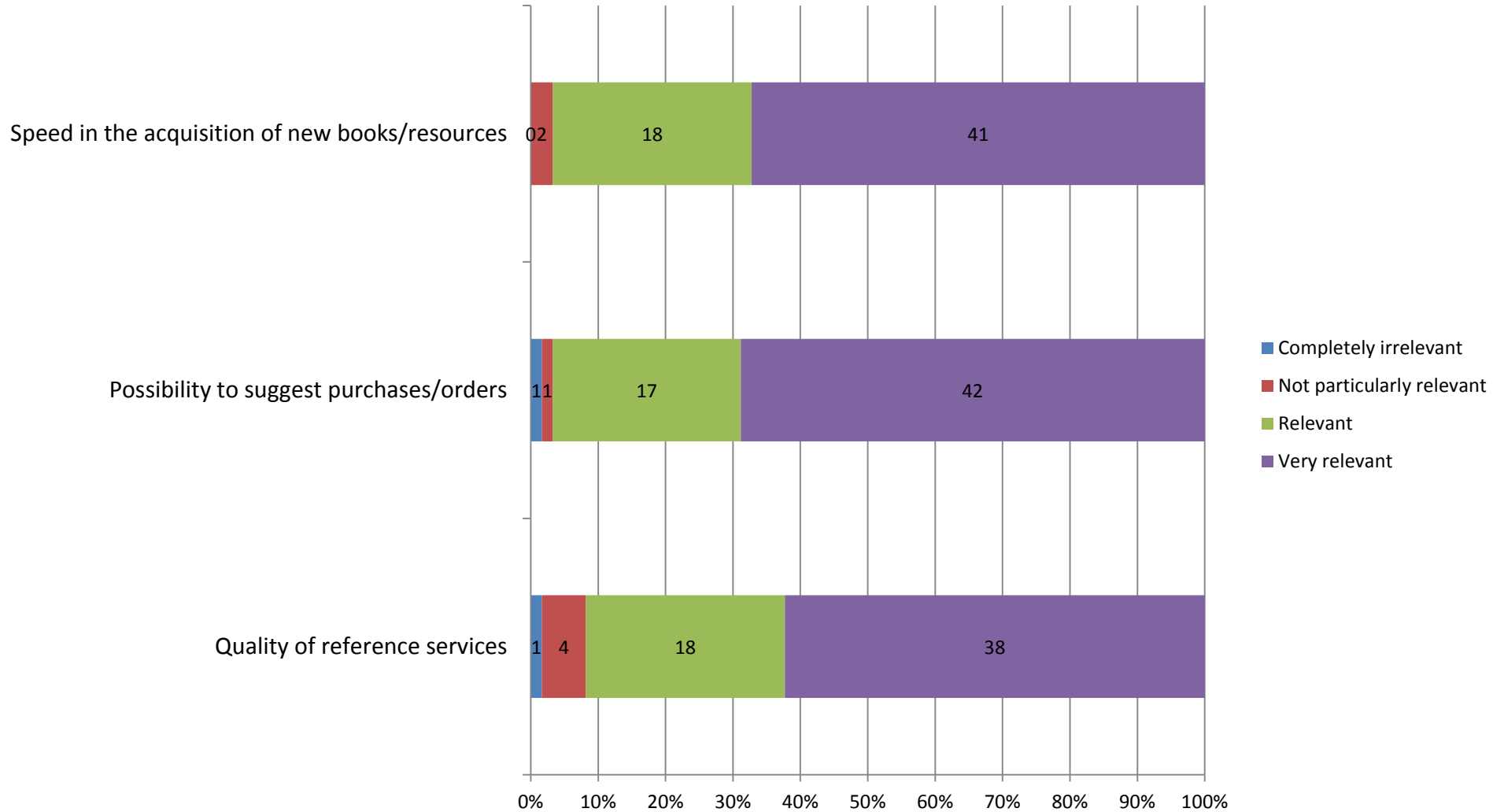

The Survey

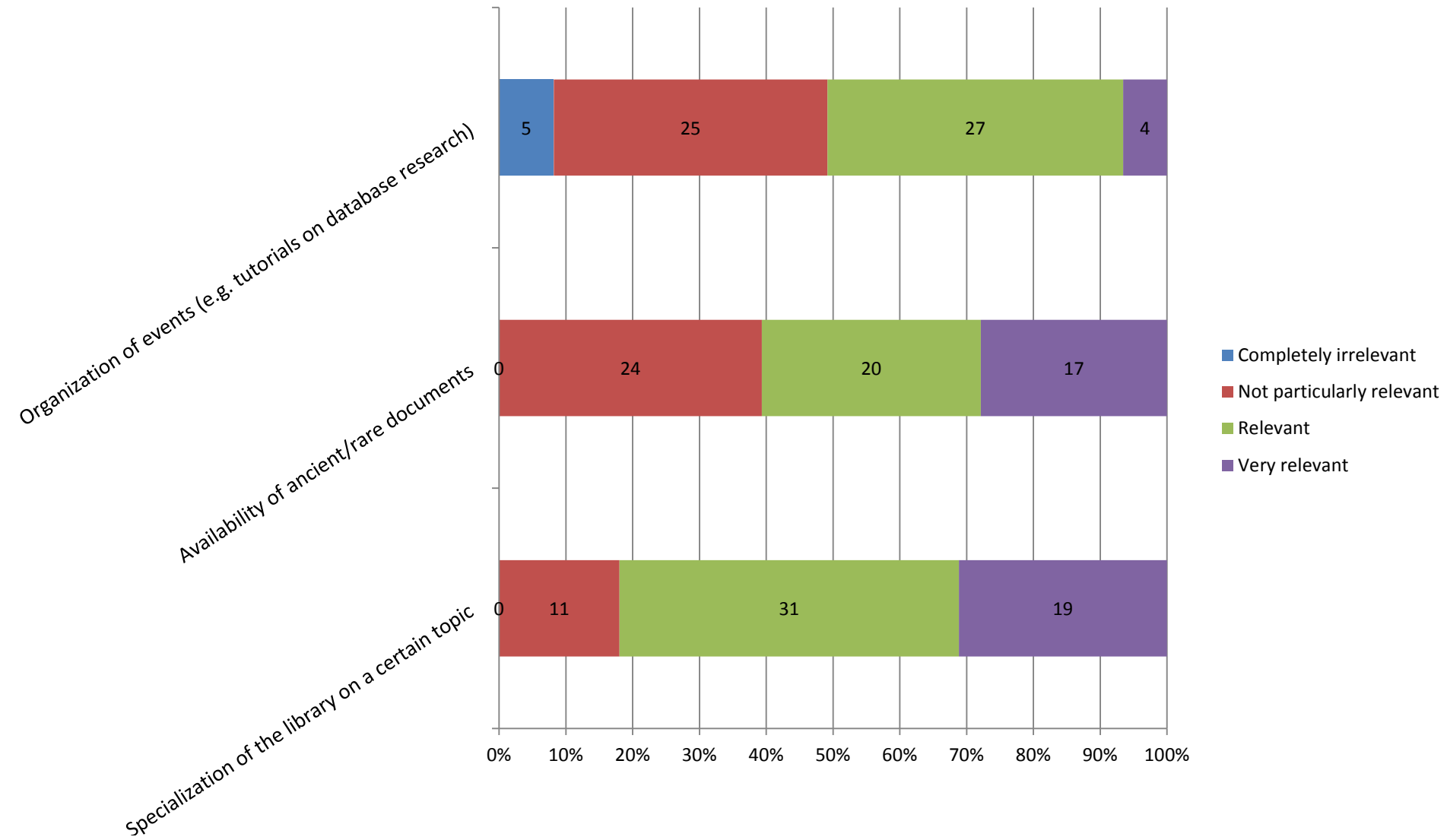
- Online Survey run on SurveyMonkey

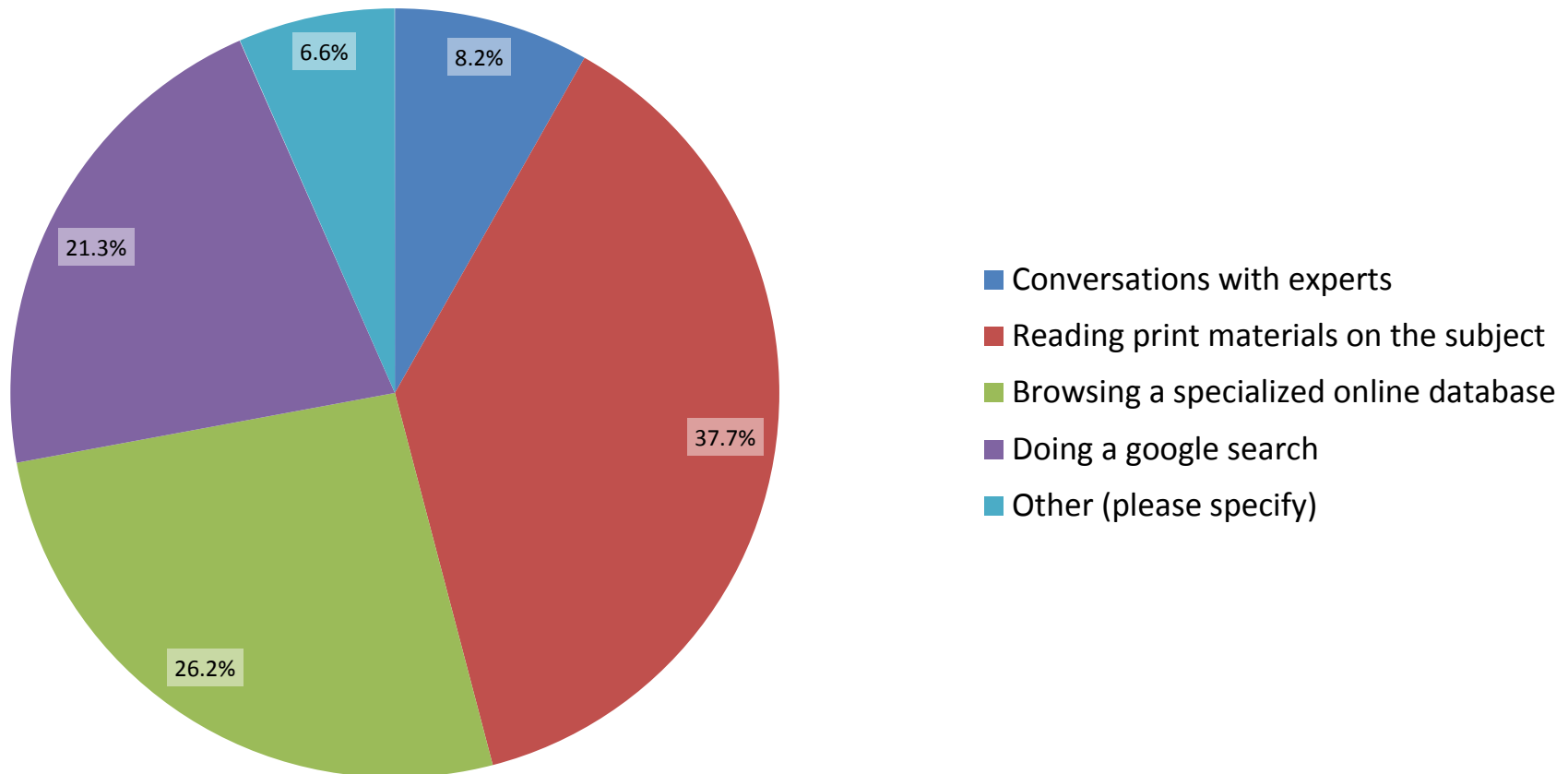


Supportiveness of the Library/1

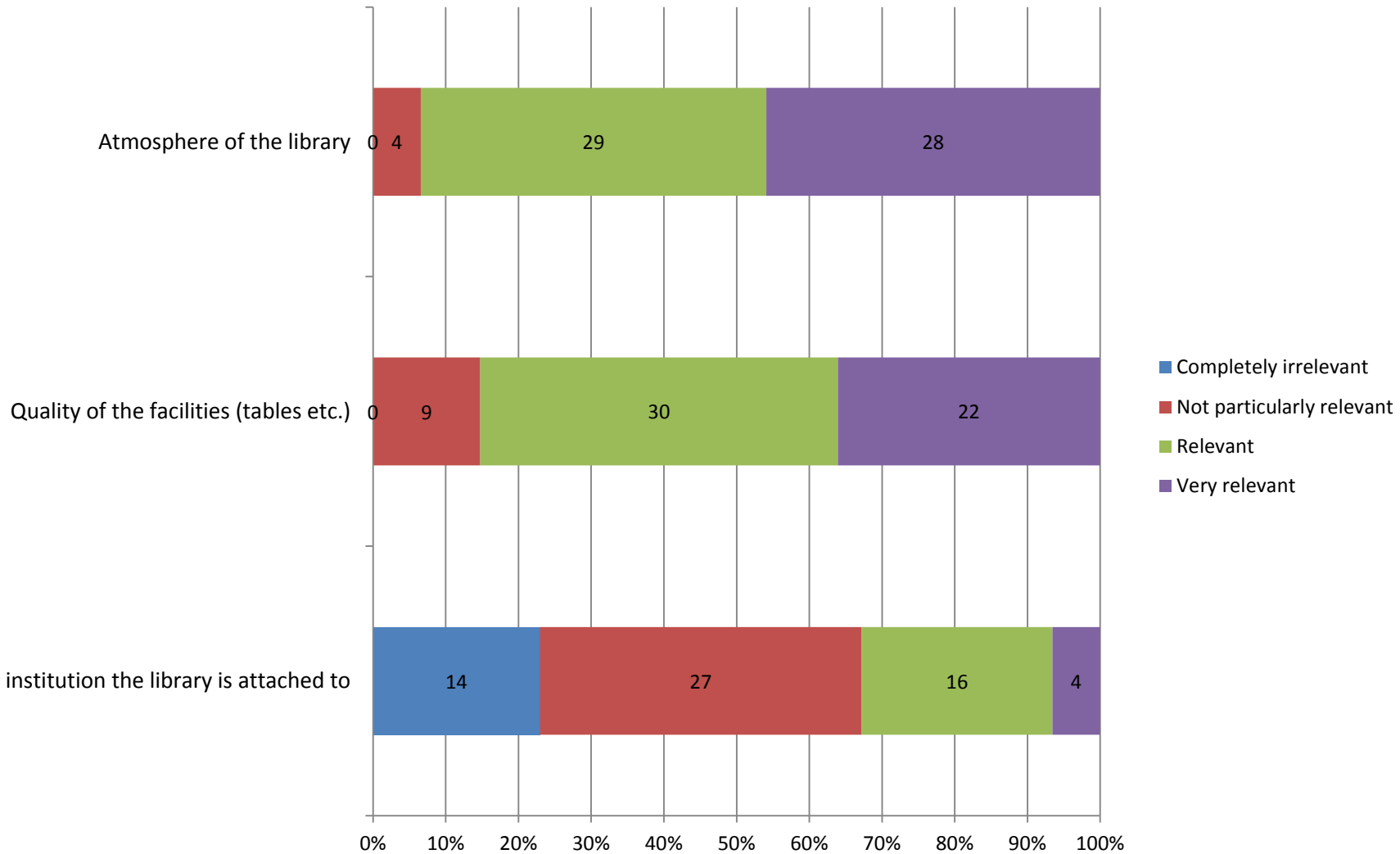

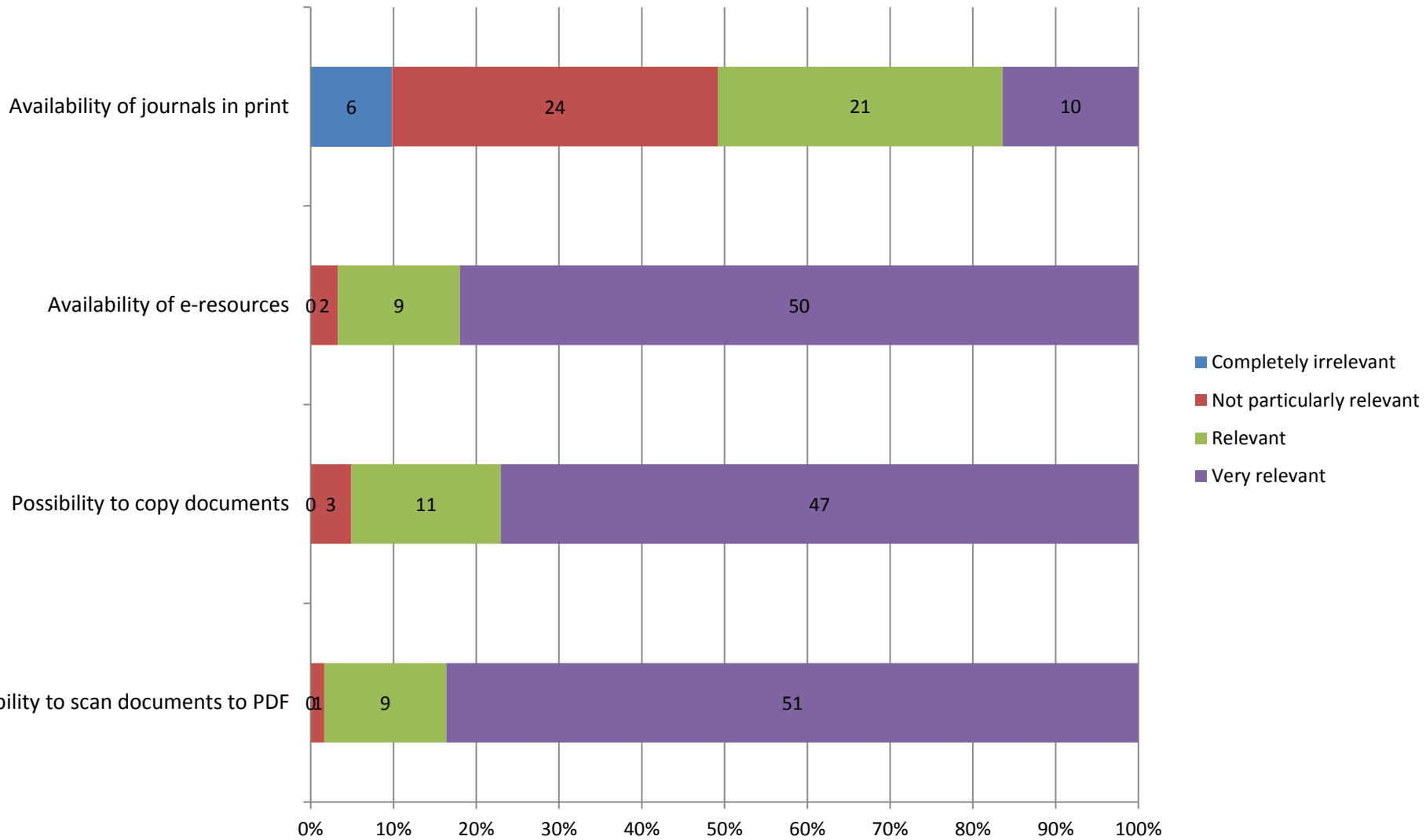
When you approach a new research topic, where do you usually start from?

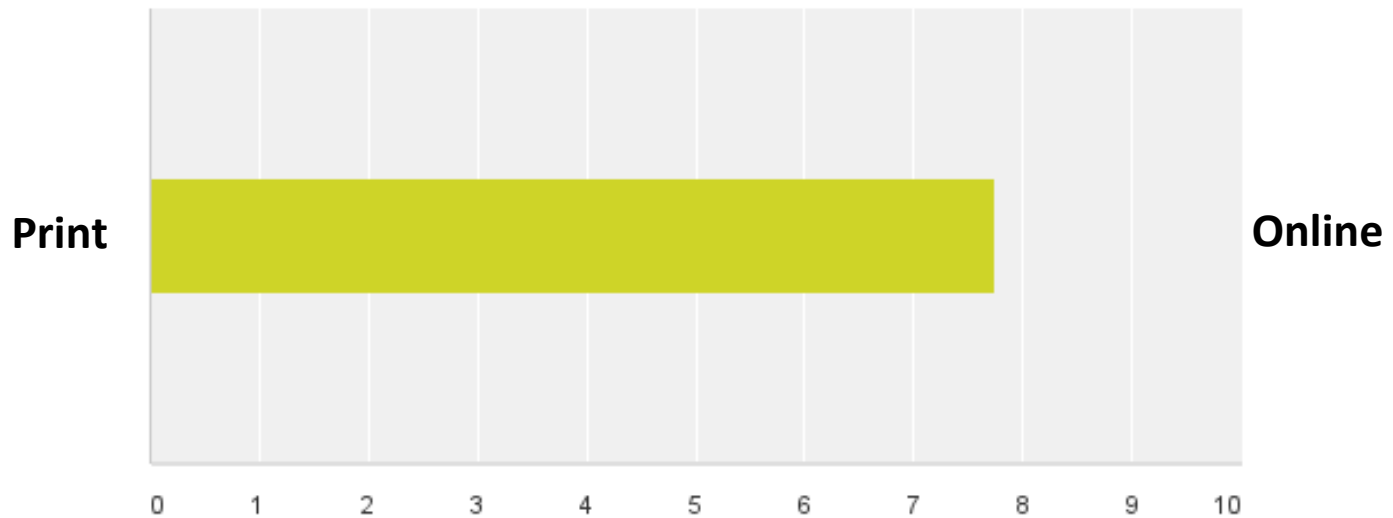

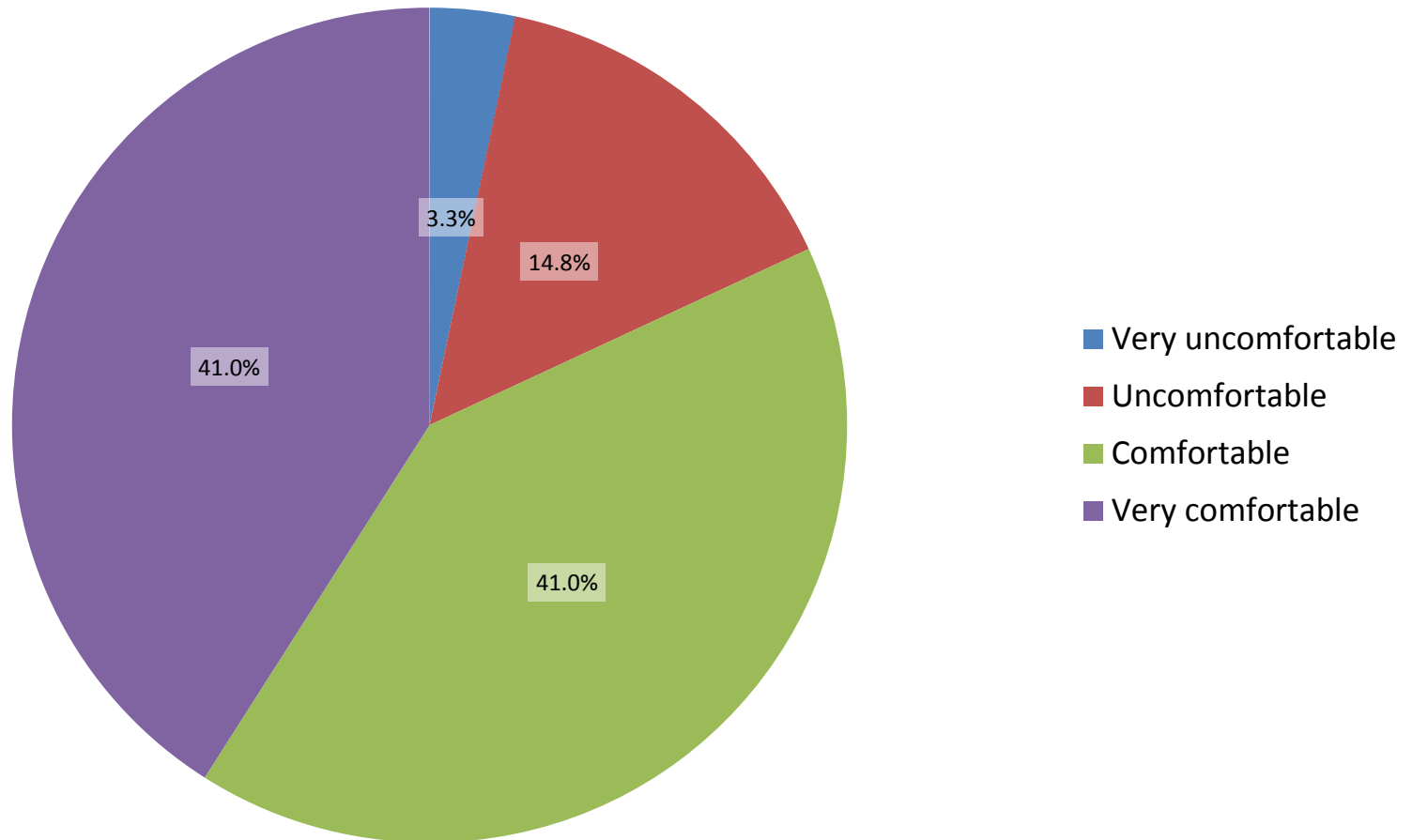
Q3 When a journal is available both in print and online, which one do you prefer?

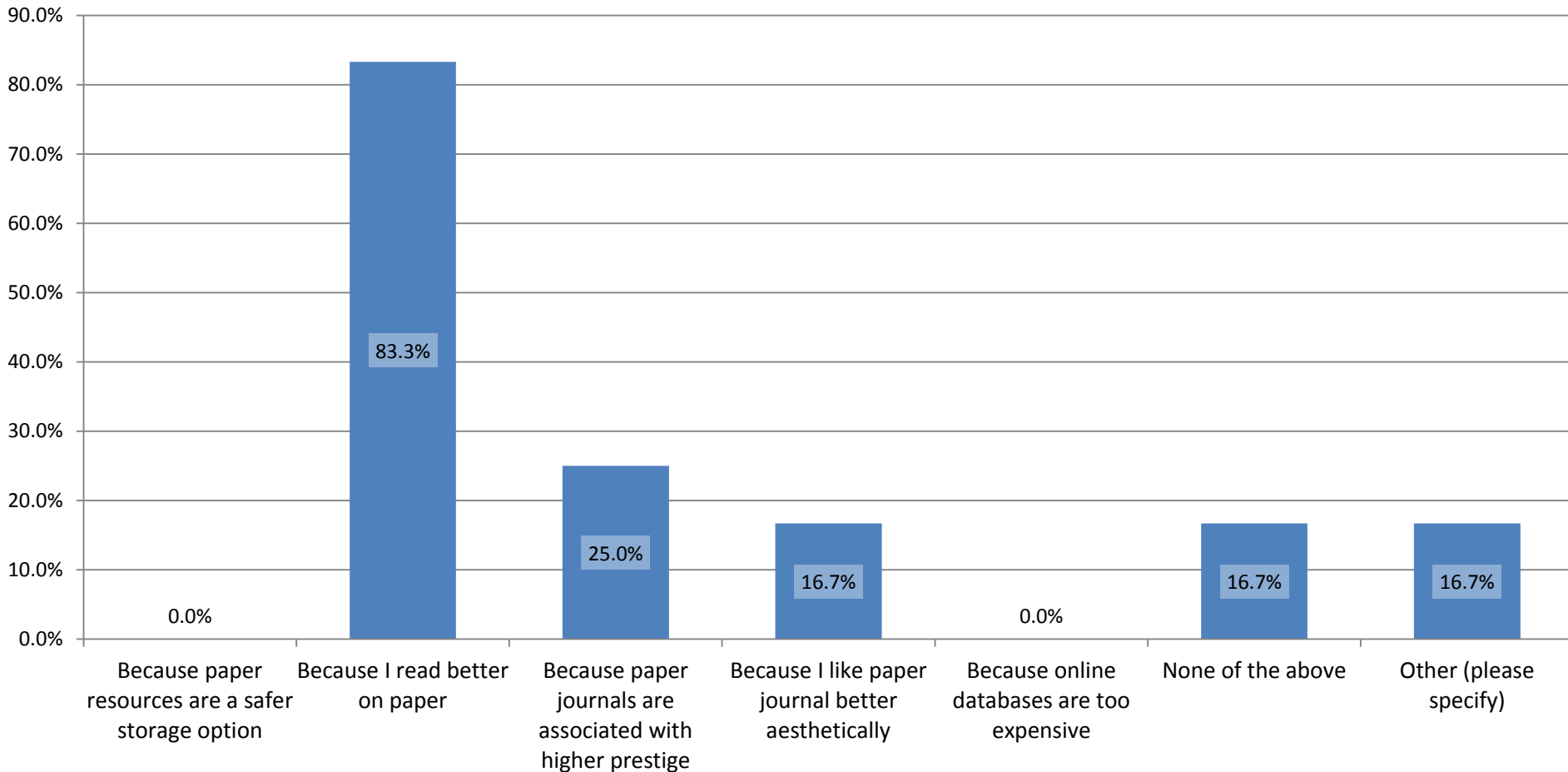

Would you be comfortable with a complete transition to online publication for journals (i.e. phasing out paper journals)?



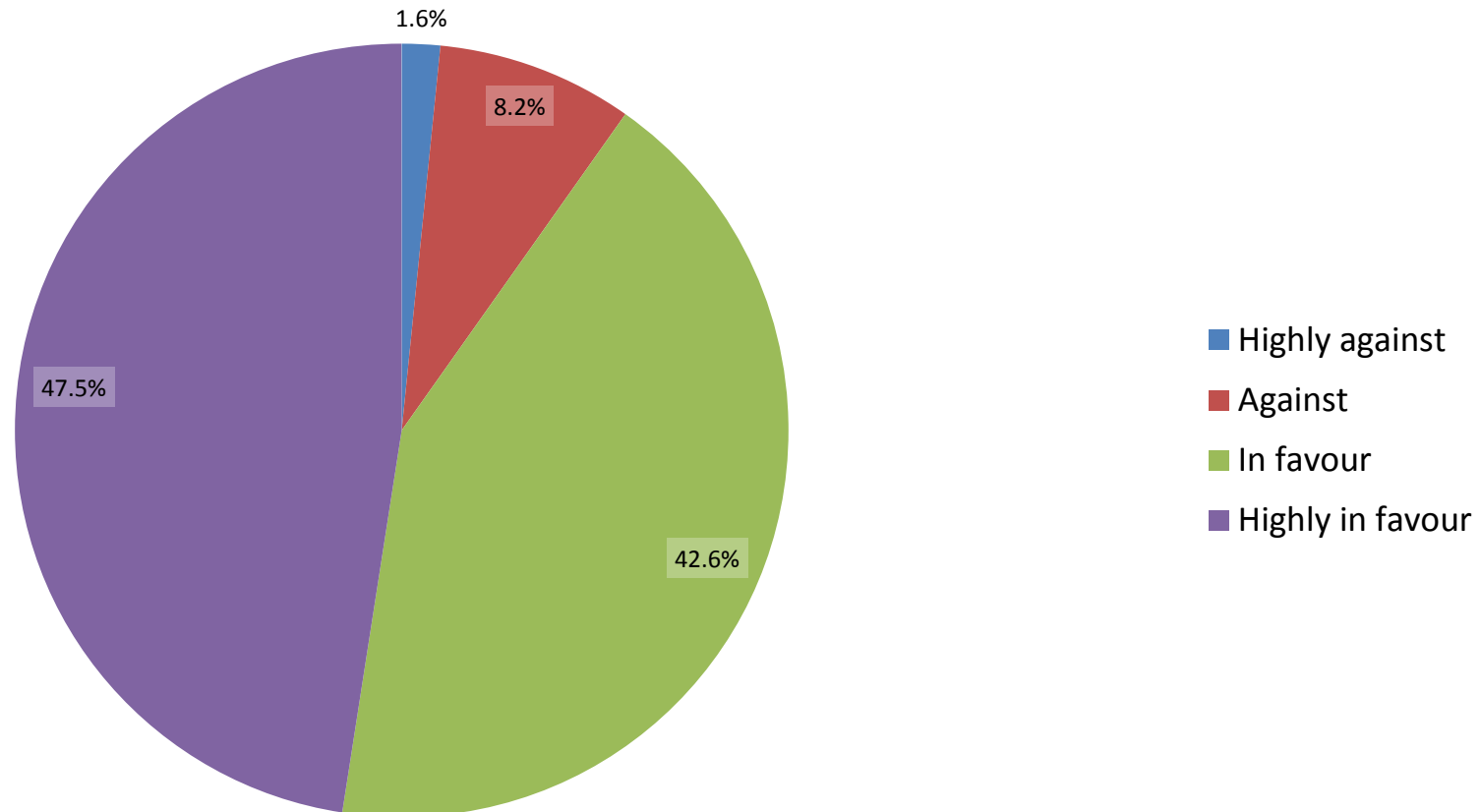
